- Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate and other competitors.
- Competitors/participants are to always uphold the rules and regulations of Perth Regional Appaloosa Club and the AQHA.
- Competitors/participants are to always demonstrate good sportsmanship, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated.
- No alcohol is allowed in, or can be consumed in the marshalling areas, working arenas or show pen/contest areas.
- All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be in that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contest, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form.
- All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth attend that event.
- Youth **MUST WEAR** an Australian Standard Approved Helmet whilst always riding within the showgrounds.
- All Amateur events you must hold a Current Amateur Card with your respective breed to enter.
- This show is run under AQHA Rules. The new rule book is available on the AQHA website. It is your responsibility to be up to date with all the rules.
- State Equestrian Centre venue charges must be paid correctly.
- All EA members must provide the current financial membership for the 2024 year. Memberships can be renewed online, visit the SEC website for further information (Recreational memberships are \$120.00 per year)

- AAA Insurance Levy is charged at \$10.00 per horse, no exceptions.
- Halter Horses entered must be registered with their respective breed and entered in the correct registration category. All owners and all exhibitors must be current financial members of their respective breed to be eligible for entry.
- A copy of your membership AAA/AQHA or PHAA membership card **MUST BE ATTACHED TO YOUR ENTRY FORM PLEASE.**
- Weanlings cannot be shown before 1st January of their weanling year and must have reached a minimum age of eighteen (18) weeks.
- Beginner ** Walk/Trot or Jog only CANNOT compete in any other event except for horse age halter.
- All handlers and show officials must be in appropriate attire per the AQHA rule book.
- If you have more than one horse, you must have a separate handler for each horse. Dress appropriately.
- All ridden horses must be over the age of 3 years, except Ledline and Beginner Walk/Jog/Trot where the horses must be 4 years & over.
- No Training aides/equipment to be used 1 hour prior to or 1 hour after commencement of show within the official marshalling yard or the show arena.
