SHOW RULES

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Strictly no refunds after closing date.
- 2. No entry accepted with registration pending.
- 3. The committee reserves the right to alter the order of events.
- 4. This show will be judged under HSAA/AAA rules.
- 5. Horses entered must be registered with the AAA Ltd in the correct registration category.
- 6. <u>All owners and all exhibitors</u> must be current financial members of the AAA Ltd for the 2023/2024 season.
- 7. A copy of your membership AAA membership card MUST BE ATTACHED TO YOUR ENTRY FORM PLEASE. IF MEMBERSHIPS ARE NOT CURRENT YOUR ENTRY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 8. Per the AAA Rule Book Rule 8.4 should a suspended member be seen to attend a AAA event the management have the authority to stop the event until the suspended person leaves the show.
- **9.** Amateur/Novice/Masters must have a current AAA ltd 2023/2024 show card. A copy of the card must be sent with your entries.
- **10.** Most colourful horse at halter to be judged 60% on colour 40% on conformation, action substance, quality, and manners. Only "adult" (coloured registry) horses are eligible (not " b" or "bt")
- **11.** HIGH POINT AWARDS must have competed in 3/4 s of the allocated classes, except Versatility classes, where you must compete in all 3 classes.
- **12.** High point awards will be calculated as per the 6,5,4,3,2,1 system.
- 13. For tie breakers it will be as per Rule 5.26 of the AAA Ltd Rule Book.
- 14. Youth 13yrs and under in Walk/Jog classes <u>CANNOT</u> enter any other ridden class.
- **15.** To book and pay for your stables, please go to <u>www.secbrigadoon.com.au</u> or call (08) 92961200
- **16. Classes 41,42,43, 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69** are designed for horses that may be either unbroken or unrideable, allowing the owner/handler to participate in more than simple halter classes. Any horse entered in this class is not allowed to enter in ANY ridden classes throughout the entirety of this show.
- Weanlings cannot be shown before 1st January of their weanling year and must have reached a minimum age of eighteen (18) weeks.
- **18.** Beginner ****** Walk/Trot only <u>CANNOT</u> compete in any other event except for horse age halter.
- **19.** All handlers must be in appropriate attire per the AAA Ltd rule book.
- **20.** If you have more than one horse, you must have a separate handler for each horse. Dress appropriately
- **21.** Ledline and Walk/Jog Horses must be 4 yrs and over
- 22. Ranch Riding Horses must be 3 yrs and over.
- **23.** No Training aides/equipment to be used 1 hour prior to or 1 hour after commencement of show within the official marshalling yard or the show arena.
- 24. No alcohol to be consumed within the stable block or the arena and surrounds.
- **25.** Youth **MUST WEAR** an Australian Standard Approved Helmet whilst riding within the showgrounds at all times.
- 26. State Equestrian Centre venue charges must be paid correctly.
- **27.** All EA members must provide the current financial membership for the 2024 year. Memberships can be renewed online, visit the SEC website for further information (Recreational memberships are \$120.00 per year)
- 28. AAA Insurance Levy is charged at \$10.00 per horse, no exceptions.
